

Robert G. Shelnett (Citizenship) Memorial Scholarship Application

Athens Technical College (ATC) awards a series of competitive merit scholarships, funded by the ATC Foundation. These merit based scholarships can only be used at ATC and are **awarded yearly**. The Financial Aid Office, in Room H-700, will complete the application process spring semester of every year with a deadline in April. Applicants who are awarded scholarships will have the funds available beginning in the fall semester. This application is for:

Robert G. Shelnett Memorial Scholarship – the applicant who demonstrates the highest-level evidence of good citizenship, work ethics, and leadership will be selected as the recipient of this scholarship

The ATC Merit Scholarships award at the equivalent rate of the cost of tuition and fees for up to two terms of full-time enrollment at ATC. The maximum amount of the scholarship is based on the current cost of attendance (tuition and mandatory fees) and is subject to availability of funds at the ATC Foundation. For 2012-2013, the maximum award is \$2060. These funds can be disbursed directly to the student, applied toward tuition and fees at ATC, or used for books and supplies at the ATC Campus Bookstore. The scholarships are disbursed on a by-term basis, and the disbursement cannot surpass the amount of tuition and fees the scholarship recipient is assessed for a given term or \$2060 for the academic year.

The requirements for the ATC Merit Based Scholarships are: 1. Complete an application, 2. Write a letter to the Scholarship Selection Committee, 3. Complete a resume, 4. Request a letter of recommendation from a program director or instructor at ATC, 5. and have completed 16 semester hours of work at Athens Technical College with a GPA of 3.0 or higher (students sign a release form for the Financial Aid Office to get their ATC transcript).

ATC will permanently withdraw any remaining scholarship funds if a student's GPA drops below a 3.00, or if the student graduates or leaves ATC for two consecutive terms. Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress toward the completion of their program of study. A student will be required to reimburse their scholarship if they withdraw from classes within seven calendar days of the start of the term, or if they drop a course during the official drop/add period.

To process scholarships, students must visit the Financial Aid Office, Room H-700, and see the Scholarship Coordinator **EACH Term** to fill out the appropriate paper work. Financial Aid will NOT disburse scholarship funds without the signature and permission of the student.

Applications for the Robert G. Shelnett (Citizenship) Memorial Scholarship must be received in the Financial Aid Office, Room H-700, by Wednesday, April 11, 2012 at 4:00 PM. Recipients of the ATC Merit Scholarships are awarded and notified by mail prior to the last day of the Spring Quarter.
