Athens Technical College Elbert County Campus Child Care Center Named Center of Distinction

Athens Technical College was named a Center of Distinction by Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (Bright from the Start). The Center of Distinction is awarded to child care centers that provide quality childcare for children 0-4.

“We congratulate the staff at Athens Technical College for earning the Center of Distinction certificate,” said Bright from the Start’s Commissioner, Marsha H. Moore. “The certificate means that the center is providing exemplary care. Centers that earn this distinction are providing children with appropriate nurturing and educational activities that stimulate healthy development and learning.”

Two of the most stringent nationally recognized evaluation instruments in the country are used to evaluate centers that apply to the program, the Infant/Toddler Environment Rating Scale-Revised (TERS-R) assesses the quality of center-based care for children up to 30 months of age; and the Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale-Revised (ECERS-R) assesses the quality of center-based child care for children from 30 to 60 months of age.

Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (Bright from the Start) is the new department of state government dedicated to child care and education for children from birth through four years of age.
