Elbert County Campus hosting chili cook-off Jan. 30



The Athens Tech Student Advisory Council (ATSAC) is seeking volunteers to test their culinary prowess in the Elbert County Campus' inaugural chili cook-off, slated to take place from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., Monday, Jan. 30, in the Student Center of the ATC Elbert County Campus.

ATSAC already has signed up Elbert County Campus custodian Mark Andrews and three other chili chefs to showcase their recipes. Andrews will be cooking his "Firehouse" chili, which won rave reviews four years ago in a chili cook-off held as a fundraiser for the Elbert County Relay for Life, benefiting the American Cancer Society.

Chili cook-off organizer Nathan Loyd, evening administrator for ATC's Elbert County Campus, said he would like to have 10 volunteers – any ATC students, faculty or staff members – making chili for the Jan. 30 event. ATSAC is furnishing all the paper, supplies, chili toppings and drinks.

In the past, ATSAC has sponsored pizza parties and cook-outs, but decided to try a different approach with the chili cook-off, Loyd said.

The chili cook-off is open to all ATC students, faculty and staff.
