- 1) Completed and signed application for admission and a \$20 nonrefundable application fee;
- 2) Official high school or GED transcripts and/or official college transcripts from all colleges attended in the past (see *General Admission Requirements from the ATC Catalog*);
- 3) Submit valid ASSET, COMPASS, SAT or ACT test scores and:
- 4) Submit National League for Nursing Pre-Admission RN Examination, AD Composite Score of no less than 75<sup>th</sup> percentile. (*All test scores must be less than five years old on the intent deadline date. See Placement Test score policy in the current ATC Catalog.*)
- 5) Provide documentation showing the completion of the prerequisite general education courses or their equivalent as listed in the *Curriculum* section of the ADN Curriculum Outline. **It is the APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY to confirm the transferability of courses taken at other colleges and universities with the ATC Registrar NO LATER than February 1 of the year in which acceptance to the program is sought.**
- 6) Submit documentation of a current LPN license valid in the state of Georgia and show a minimum of two years work experience as a licensed practical nurse.
