

# DMS Applicant Check List for Fall 2010

## Requirements for application to the DMS program prior to the application deadline May 1, 2010:

- 1. Completed and signed application for college admission and a nonrefundable \$20.00 application fee
- 2. Documentation of attendance at a DMS Information/Advising Session and signed DMS General Technical Requirement form. These are delivered to admissions by the DMS Program Chair and inserted in your DMS application packet in admissions.
- 3. Documentation of score from TEAS, a standardized health program placement examination. Information, including ATC registration requirement and cost available from the ATC Testing Services beginning in Jan. 2010. There is a study guide for TEAS that they offer online at [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com) which students can purchase for \$38.95. There is also a practice exam they can purchase with the study guide for a total of \$60.00.
- 4. Documentation of completion of the following with a minimum grade of C in each course:
  - college algebra (MAT 1111)
  - physics (PHY 1110)
  - introduction to health care (AHS 104)
  - medical terminology (AHS 109)
  - anatomy and physiology I (BIO 2113)
  - anatomy and physiology I (BIO 2114)
  - college speech (SPC 1101)

Applicants transferring from other colleges must confirm the transferability of credit for these courses with the ATC director of registration and records by the application deadline;
- 5. Documentation showing completion of 20 hours of observation in an ultrasound department (blank DMS observation forms are available from the Admissions Office, at the mandatory DMS program information session, and online at [www.athenstech.edu](http://www.athenstech.edu)—Select *Prospective Students* and then *Competitive Health Pgms*); attach completed forms;
- 6. Documentation showing completion of a minimum two hours as a volunteer model in the ATC sonography classroom lab; documentation of your participation is completed during volunteer session by DMS faculty and must be submitted with other DMS application documents in your DMS application packet in admissions.

- 7. Completed and signed Intent form (blank forms are available from the Admissions Office, at the mandatory DMS program information session, and online at [www.athenstech.edu](http://www.athenstech.edu)—Select *Prospective Students* and then *Competitive Health Pgms*);

**All Remaining DMS Prerequisite Courses MUST be completed prior to the DMS coursework. It is highly recommended to complete all coursework prior to application in the case of identical ranking scores; completion of all courses adds points in the ranking.**
