**The following items must be completed prior to the application deadline of the year for which the student would like to be considered as a candidate for The Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program:**

In addition to submitting the documentation outlined in the section on *General Admission Requirements*, DMS applicants must submit the following to the Admissions Office:

- a. Documentation of attendance at the mandatory program information session;
- b. Documentation of completion of prerequisite general education courses – college algebra (MAT 1111), physics (PHY 1110), and speech (SPC 1101) – and prerequisite health core courses – anatomy and physiology I and II (BIO 2113 and BIO 2114), introductory health care (AHS 104), and medical terminology (AHS 109) – with a minimum grade of C in each course (applicants transferring from other colleges must confirm the transferability of credit for those courses with the ATC director of registration and records by the application deadline);
- c. Documentation of score from TEAS, a standardized health program placement examination. Information, including ATC registration requirement and cost available from the ATC Testing Services beginning in Jan. 2010.
- d. Documentation showing the completion of a minimum of two hours as a volunteer in the Classroom Sonography Lab, Documentation forms are sent to the Admissions Office by each applicant with the DMS application form(s) completed during volunteer session.
- e. Documentation of **20** hours of observation in an ultrasound department (blank DMS observation forms are available from the Admissions Office, at the mandatory DMS mandatory program information session, and online at [www.athenstech.edu](http://www.athenstech.edu)–Select *Prospective Students* and then *Competitive Health Pgms*);
- f. A completed and signed DMS intent form (blank DMS intent forms are available from the Admissions Office, at the mandatory DMS mandatory program information session, and online at [www.athenstech.edu](http://www.athenstech.edu)–Select *Prospective Students* and then *Competitive Health Pgms*).
