The following items must be completed prior to the application deadline of August 1st of the year for which the student would like to be considered as a candidate for the EMT Intermediate Program.

- 1) Completed and signed ATC Admission Application and \$20 Application Fee;
- 2) Official birth certificates, passports, driver's licenses or state-issued photo identification card to document that the applicant is at least 18 years of age;
- 3) Official High School or GED transcripts and/or official college transcripts from ALL colleges attended in the past;
- 4) Completed and signed Intent form;
- 5) Valid COMPASS test scores showing a minimum score of a 27-Writing, 72-Reading, and 35-Numeric.

The EMT-I Program at Athens Technical College utilizes a competitive admission process to select students. Program faculty and the Admissions staff designed the process to ensure maximum opportunity for student success in the program.

This program covers both the U.S. Department of Transportation 1985 Emergency Medical Technician Intermediate Curriculum and the 1995 Emergency Medical Technician- Basic Curriculum. The EMT- Intermediate Program is designed to provide additional training and increased knowledge and skills in specific aspects of advanced life support above the basic level. **Successful completion of the program allows the graduate to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician EMT-I Certification Examination and receive Georgia Certification.**
