The following items must be completed prior to the application deadline of July 1 of the year for which the student would like to be considered as a candidate for the Practical Nursing Program

- 1) Completed and signed ATC Admission Application and \$20 Application Fee
- 2) Official transcripts showing a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale on all college work attempted.
- 3) Official birth certificates, passports, driver's licenses or state-issued photo identification card to document that the applicant is at least 17 years of age.
- 4) Valid ASSET, COMPASS, SAT or ACT Test scores; AND
- 5) Submit National League for Nursing Pre-Admission PN Examination, Composite Score of no less than 50<sup>th</sup> percentile. (*All test scores must be less than five years old on the intent deadline date. See Placement Test score policy in the current ATC Catalog.*)
- 6) Complete general and health core courses in English (ENG 101), Mathematics (MAT 101) psychology (PSY 101) anatomy and physiology (AHS 101) and medical terminology (AHS 109) or equivalent courses by July 1 of the year in which admission is sought. **It is the APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY to confirm the transferability of courses taken at other colleges and universities with the ATC Registrar NO LATER than the JULY 1 Intent Deadline.**
- 7) Completed and signed Intent Form.
