The following items must be completed prior to the **application deadline (July 1st)** of the year for which the student would like to be considered as a candidate for the ATC Veterinary Technology Program:

1. Completed and signed ATC Admission Application and application fee (New Students); or Program Transfer Form (Current Students); or Readmission Form (Former Students);
2. Sealed, official transcripts from all colleges previously attended. Sealed, official high school transcripts should be submitted if the applicant has not previously attended any college;
3. Documentation of completion of college **algebra** (MAT 1111), **biology** (BIO 1111) and **chemistry** (CHM 1111) or equivalent courses with final course grades of C or better;
4. SAT scores that are less than five years old (required of **ALL** Veterinary Technology Program applicants);
5. Completed and signed Veterinary Technology Program Intent Form;
6. A personal statement essay with attached Personal Statement Guidelines and Signature Form;
7. A photocopy of the applicant's official birth certificate, passport, driver's license or state-issued photo identification card to document that the applicant is at least 18 years old;
8. The signature form included in the Veterinary Technology Program Policies and Procedures Manual confirming that they have reviewed and understood the material included in the manual;
9. Completed and signed Felony, Drug Testing & Background Check Acknowledgement Form.

Program faculty members recommend that applicants to the program have volunteer or paid practical experience in a veterinary hospital or an animal care facility prior to seeking admission to the program. This experience should be under the supervision of a registered veterinary technician or a licensed doctor of veterinary medicine. While there is no specific requirement for the number of hours of experience, it is important that the applicant be fully aware of the profession and job requirements prior to enrolling in the program.
