The COVID-19 Pandemic has disrupted students in a number of ways generating financial hardships related to employment, housing, childcare, food, utilities, and medical expenses. To provide our eligible spring students the available financial assistance Athens Technical College will award students emergency aid grants based on the following distribution formula.

Even Distribution: Athens Technical College has identified 1,980 students for the spring semester and approximately 1,100 for the summer semester that meet the eligibility criteria and Athens Technical College has identified this student population as having been 'impacted or disrupted by COVID-19'.
