






First to Second Year Retention Rates of First-Time Degree Seeking Students

Graduation Rates by Time to Completion:

Graduation rates can be measured over different lengths of time. "Normal time" is the typical amount of time it takes full-time students to complete their program. For example, the "normal" time it takes for many associate degree programs in 2 years. Not all students complete within the normal time, so graduation rates are measured by the lengths of time as well, including "150% of normal time" (e.g. 3 years for a 2-year program) and "200% of normal time," or twice as long as the normal time (e.g. 4 years for a 2-program).
